- ➔ Find out where tables and chairs are kept.
- ➔ Establish where tea, coffee and juices are stored and if there are any rules about refreshments during meetings.
- ➔ Check out the Noticeboard to keep up to date.
- ➔ Younger children may accompany you on your rota evening or at camp but are your responsibility at all times.
